

## Osmo Prep – Morning Exams

Osmo Prep is a prescription drug. A few days before your appointment, take your prescription to the pharmacy and purchase one 32 tablet bottle.

### Five days before your procedure:

- Stop Aspirin, Plavix, and Coumadin.
- Notify your Cardiologist and ask if they want to replace these medications with Lovenox during this time.
- Stop Iron supplements and multivitamins with iron.
- Avoid eating seeds, nuts, corn, and foods containing nuts and seeds.

### Day before your procedure:

- Stop Arthritis Medications such as Advil, Aleve, Motrin, and Ibuprofen. Tylenol is allowed.
- Begin your clear liquid diet at breakfast: water, apple juice, white cranberry/white grape juice, Gatorade/PowerAde, beef/chicken bouillon, Jell-O, Popsicles, sprite/gingerale, tea, and black coffee (no cream).
- **Avoid: Red and purple fluids, solid food, milk products, and alcohol.**

### Osmo Prep Schedule

- The Osmo Prep bottle contains 32 pills, you will take 20 pills at 2:00 p.m. and 12 pills at 8:00 p.m. as instructed below...
- **Day before procedure, at 2:00 p.m.** take four (4) Osmo Prep tablets with 8 to 12 ounces of any clear liquid every 15 minutes until a total of 20 tablets have been taken. (You will be taking 4 pills at 2:00, 2:15, 2:30, 2:45, and 3:00 p.m.)
- **Day before the procedure at 8:00 p.m.** take four (4) Osmo Prep tablets with 8 to 12 ounces of any clear liquid every 15 minutes until a total of 12 tables have been taken. (You will be taking pills at 8:00, 8:15, and 8:30 p.m.)

### Day of the Procedure

- **Do not drink or eat anything after midnight.**
- You may take your heart, blood pressure, seizure, or anxiety medicines with a small amount of water BEFORE you leave home. Check with your physician if you have any questions about medications to be taken prior to your procedure.
- Do not take oral diabetic medications the morning of your procedure.
